# Freedom of Information - SA Water Dividend Projections

I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), received by the Department of Treasury and Finance (DTF) on 23 January 2023.

Your application specifically requested:

'Please provide all records and documents, including but not limited to emails, text messages, diary entries, and any other forms of correspondence, that pertain to communication between the Department of Treasury and Finance and the Treasurer, as well as any correspondence that pertain to communication between Department of Treasury and Finance and the Treasurers Chief of Staff and/or the Minister's advisers and/or administrative staff, in relation to the provision of advice on SA Waters dividend projections for 2024 to 2028. Date Range: 21/03/2022 to 19/01/2023'

A total of 2 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application and I have determined as follows:

- I grant you access in part to 1 document, a copy of which is enclosed, and
- I refuse you access to 1 document.

Please refer to the attached schedule that describes each document and sets out my determination and reasons in summary form.

Note that the 2022-2023 Budget and the 2022-2023 MYBR include information on SA Water dividend projections, which is publicly available on the Department of Treasury and Finance website.


