Freedom of Information – Redeployed, retrained or redundant employees

I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), received by the Department of Treasury and Finance (DTF) on 9 December 2021.

Your application specifically requested:

'A copy of the most recent report on agency strategies and performance made to the Commissioner for Public Sector Employment about redeployment, retraining and redundancy arrangements. All documents that detail the current number of employees that are under redeployment, retraining and redundancy arrangements and a breakdown of the number of employees that have been redeployed, retrained or made redundant over the past 12 months. Date Range: 8/12/2020 to 8/12/2021'

After consultation with your office, the scope was amended to the following:

'A report about the current number of employees that are under redeployment, retraining and redundancy arrangements and a breakdown of the number of employees that have been redeployed, retrained or made redundant over the past 12 months. Date Range: 08/12/2020 to 08/12/2021'

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of my determination.
