### Freedom of Information – Advice to the Treasurer about KordaMentha

I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), received by the Department of Treasury and Finance (DTF) on 3 December 2018.

Your application specifically requested:

'All advice to the Treasurer (including but not limited to notes, memos, minutes, briefings, emails, meeting notes, reports and documents) relating to KordaMentha's review and subsequent administration of the Central Adelaide Local Health Network. From 1 July 2018'

Under the Act, an agency has 30 days to respond to a freedom of information request. As DTF did not respond to your request within the time frame required, the department is deemed to have refused you access to all documents relevant to your application. However, I have determined to process the request as if the statutory time frame had been met.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of my determination.

A total of 17 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application and I have determined as follows:

- I grant you access in full to 4 documents, copies of which are enclosed
- I grant you access in part to 4 documents, copies of which are enclosed, and
- I refuse you access to 9 documents.

Please refer to the attached schedule that describes each document and sets out my determination and reasons in summary form.

### Documents released in full

Documents 1 - 4

### Documents released in part

Documents 2a

This document contains information relating to the personal affairs of third parties. Under clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 to the Act, a document is exempt if its disclosure would involve the 'unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person'. This information falls within the definition of personal affairs under the Act and is therefore exempt from release pursuant to clause 6(1).

Documents 5 and 7 - 8

Sections not relevant to your application have been removed.

### Documents refused in full

Documents 6a and 13

These document are drafts of documents specifically prepared for submission to Cabinet. I have therefore determined to refuse access to these documents in full pursuant to clause 1(1)(b)

Documents 6 and 14

These documents consist of extracts from documents which were submitted to Cabinet and are therefore exempt pursuant to clause 1(1)(c).

Documents 9, 10 and 12

These documents are briefing papers specifically prepared for the use of the Minister in relation to a matter submitted to Cabinet. I have therefore exempted the documents pursuant to clause 1(1)(f) of the FOI Act

Documents 1a and 11

These documents are briefing notes prepared specifically for use in Parliament, the disclosure of which would infringe the privilege of Parliament. I have therefore determined to exempt the documents in full pursuant to clause 17(c) of Schedule 1 to the FOI Act.

### **Exemptions**

### Clause 1 - Cabinet documents

- (1) A document is an exempt document -
  - (b) if it is a preliminary draft of a document referred to in paragraph (1); or
  - (c) if it is a document that is a copy of or part of, or contains an extract from, a document referred to in paragraph (a) or (b); or
  - (f) if it is a briefing paper specifically prepared for the use of a Minister in relation to a matter submitted, or proposed to be submitted to Cabinet.

### Clause 17 - Documents subject to contempt etc

A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the public disclosure of which would, but for any immunity of the Crown—

(c) infringe the privilege of Parliament

Please note, in compliance with Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045 - *Disclosure Logs for Non-Personal Information Released through Freedom of Information* (PC045), DTF is now required to publish a log of all non-personal information released under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*.

### **Appeal Rights**

If you are aggrieved with this determination, you have a right to apply for internal review under subsection 29(1) of the FOI Act. Pursuant to subsection 29(2), your application must:

- be lodged at an office of DTF, or emailed to <u>freedomofinformation2@sa.gov.au</u> within 30 days after the day on which you receive this letter or within such further time as the principal officer may allow.


