

APPLICATION UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1991

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), received in this office on 19 March 2019.

Your application seeks access to:

"All files, reports, notes, emails, briefings, ministerial minutes and documents held by the office of the Hon Rob Lucas MLC (Treasurer, Minister for Finance) Ministerial Office relating to the Wright Electorate Office, from 1 August 2018 to date."

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of my determination. An extensive search was conducted within this office. A total of 5 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application

I grant you access in full to 1 document; a copy of which is enclosed. I grant you access in part to 2 documents, copies of which are enclosed. I refuse you access to 2 documents.

Document 3 is a table showing the current status of electorate office relocation and works. All other information not pertaining to the Wright electorate office has been redacted as being out of scope.

Document 4 is a briefing prepared by DTF about funding supplementation and expenditure authority for the relocation of certain electorate offices. All other information not pertaining to the Wright electorate office has been redacted as being out of scope.

Documents refused in full

Document 2 is a Parliamentary Briefing Notes which was prepared specifically for use in Parliament, the disclosure of which would infringe the privilege of Parliament. I have therefore determined exempt this document in full pursuant to clause 17(c) of Schedule 1 to the FOI Act.

Document 5 is a copy of my determination letter, dated 9 September 2018, to your FOI request seeking access to all files, reports, emails and documents held by the office of the Hon Rob Lucas MLC (Treasurer, Minister for Finance) Ministerial Office relating to the Wright Electorate Office, from 17 March 2018 to date. I determine this document exempt in full, as it's publicly available on the DTF website.

ESTABLISHING NEW WRIGHT ELECTORATE OFFICE UPDATE

 note the current status of the establishment of the new Wright Electorate Office, at Manor Farm Shopping Centre, 53 Northbri Avenue, Salisbury East and the progress with the temporary co-location of the Wright EO in the Ramsay EO.

Key Points:

- The Manor Farm Shopping Centre in Salisbury East was identified as a potential office
 option by the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) through a
 physical search of the Wright Electorate, following several market calls pre and post
 State Election 2018 for both short and long term office accommodation that failed to
 deliver any suitable options.
- Lease negotiations between the Lessor of Manor Farm Shopping Centre and DPTI were productive in the early stages with a lease proposal received on 3 July 2018. DTF signed a Memorandum of Administrative Arrangement (MoAA) on 1 August 2018 with DPTI agreeing to the basic lease proposal terms and conditions.
- The lessor as part of the four year lease proposal has committed to undertaking the following works: extending shop front of the tenancy by an additional 30 square metres, installation of new ducted reverse cycle air conditioning, internal disability accessible bathroom facilities, lighting to specification, new floor coverings, a dedicated car park and multiple signage opportunities.



- The Lessor initially advised his works would be completed by 1 October 2018, therefore DTF expected to have the new office fit out completed prior to an extended lease expiry date at the existing Wright Electorate Office, Virginia of 4 May 2019. The lessor will not be handing over the tenancy to DTF before 4 May 2019.
- The lessor communicates progress with his works via an emailed weekly update forwarded to DPTI Development Division Property group. The Lessor has confirmed that the Salisbury Council have provided Development Approval with conditions to the plans submitted and that internal Lessor works at the site have commenced. The Lessor air conditioning design continues with final technical elements currently being finalised. The project schedule for the construction of the front office extension is being developed by the Lessors builder with a completion date yet to be advised. The Lessor handover date to DTF is currently unknown.
- DTF has continued to progress fit out tender documentation and is now at the stage where the documents are ready to be released once the final approval by the Lessor / Member is available to DTF.
- Further to your discussions with the Leader of the Opposition, the option of a temporary co-location of Wright Electorate Office at the Ramsay Electorate Office has been progressed. An additional ADSL line and data / power cabling to accommodate the Member for Wright and his staff in the Ramsay EO was installed in the Ramsay EO on 14 and 15 March 2019 respectively. Additional furniture has been ordered, signage is being reviewed and telecommunications / ICT arrangements are being finalised.
- Should third party suppliers meet scheduled timeframes, the temporary co-location of Wright EO to the Ramsay EO is expected to occur in early April 2019. A separate briefing is being forwarded to you outlining the expected costs associated with the temporary co-location of Wright EO at the Ramsay EO and also to provide details of the resources / support requested by the Members in relation to the co-location, for your consideration.
- Electorate Services continues to work closely with both the affected Members to facilitate a fimely resolution to the establishment of the new Wright EO at Manor Farm and the temporary co-location of Wright EO at the Ramsay EO.

Wrlght to Tenancy 2, 53 Northbri Avenue, Salisbury

Lease commencement date: 1 October 2018 (or completion of lessor works) Commencing rental per annum: \$36,000 (increase of \$360 p.a.)
EstImated fitout budget: \$150,000 (\$120,000 capital, \$30,000 operating)

- You have previously provided in principle approval for these office relocations, and the Chief Executive has authorised the Memorandum of Administrative Arrangement (MOAA) between DTF and DPTI, accepting the negotiated lease terms and conditions.
- Preliminary planning and documentation is currently underway for each of these projects.
- Electorate Services can now provide accurate cost impacts, and this submission is seeking funding supplementation and expenditure authority for the Support Services to Parliamentarians budget to enable these projects to proceed. It is not possible for these costs to be absorbed within the existing budget.
- The standard electorate office fitout costs approximately \$150,000 (dependent upon the existing condition of the premises and the works the building owner is prepared to undertake).
- The relocation of these offices will also result in increased rental charges at each of the new locations. Funding supplementation of \$62,000 for the 2018-19 financial year and \$100,000 ongoing is sought.

- DTF, Budget and Performance Branch has been consulted in relation to this proposal and should you approve this request, will make the necessary budget adjustments.
- It is recommended that you approve the funding supplementation and expenditure authority for the Support Services to Parliamentarians budget for the 2018-19 financial year and ongoing, to appropriately fund these electorate office relocations.
