AGREEMENT REACHED OVER NEW STATE-TREASURERS BODY

All state and territory governments have signed up to a new body of Treasurers, the NSW Treasurer Dominic Perrottet has announced.

Mr Perrottet said the treasurers threw their support behind the initiative during their visit to Sydney for a meeting of the Council on Federal Financial Relations (CFFR).

“The states and territories have seized the opportunity to improve our cooperation and make the whole nation stronger,” Mr Perrottet said.

“This is a great step for collaborative federalism.

“This agreement states we will:

“work together on issues of common interest, advancing national reform priorities from a state and territory perspective, including but not limited to an agenda setting role in federal affairs”

“The new Board of Treasurers will meet for the first time before the end of this year and NSW will continue to progress the administration of the new body.
