# MINERAL AND PETROLEUM EXPLORATION Mar qtr 2023

#### **SUMMARY**

During the March quarter 2023, private **mineral** exploration expenditure:

- rose 32% in South Australia in <u>seasonally</u> <u>adjusted</u> terms and was 92% higher than a year earlier
- nationally, rose 0.7% in the quarter and was
  4.0% higher than a year earlier.

N.B. Estimates of South Australian <u>petroleum</u> <u>exploration expenditure</u> were withheld from publication in the September and December quarters 2022. Consequently, the combined mineral and petroleum estimate is not available for these periods. An estimate for petroleum exploration was published for the latest March quarter 2023 period and appears as a dot in the charts where shown alone or as part of the combined total.

### **FURTHER ANALYSIS**

# **SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA**

South Australian expenditure on private mineral exploration rose 32% in the March quarter and was 92% higher than a year earlier – See Chart 2.

The 3.4% rise in national expenditure on mineral and petroleum exploration during the March quarter was driven by a 16% rise in petroleum exploration expenditure and a smaller rise of 0.7% in mineral exploration expenditure. National exploration expenditure was 1.4.% lower than a year earlier.

#### **TREND DATA**

South Australian expenditure on mineral exploration was 81% higher compared to a year earlier.

National expenditure on private mineral and petroleum exploration was 1.8% lower compared with a year earlier. Expenditure on non-petroleum exploration was 3.7% higher but for petroleum exploration was 21% lower.





Chart 2: Components of Mineral and Petroleum Exploration Expenditure, South Australia, (Seas. Adj., \$m)



## **ORIGINAL DATA**

In the March quarter 2023, non-petroleum mineral exploration expenditure in South Australia was concentrated in:

- Copper (53% of total);
- Iron ore (12% of total); and
- Uranium (9.8% of total).

Note: References to expenditure data by type of mineral sought is in original terms – the ABS does not provide these data in trend or seasonally adjusted terms
