

Key Points:

 On 27 July 2016 the former Treasurer approved \$90,000 excluding GST for refurbishment works at the Walte Electorate Office including the installation of an accessible toilet, minor alterations and maintenance works.



- The additional funding supplementation and expenditure authority over and above the former Treasurer's approval is required as the scope of works for the refurbishment has been expanded in consultation with the Member to include the following: installation of an accessible toilet, new carpet, interior painting throughout, new kitchen facilities, creation of a large open meeting space and functional staff work area, electrical / lighting alterations, relocation of communications equipment and security equipment, air conditioning alterations and upgraded storage facilities.
- The additional funding of \$72,000 for the works to be completed in the 2018-19 year, is inclusive of additional scope items and \$7,720 for staging of the proposed works which allows the electorate office to remain open whilst renovations are undertaken.
- The additional funding of \$76,200 for the works to be completed in the 2019-20 year (August 2019), includes the costs listed above plus an additional \$4,200 being builders costs associated with the commencement date being delayed.
- The Waite Electorate Office does not have toilet facilities within the office. Waite
 Electorate Office staff have raised work health and safety concerns with having to access
 these common toilet facilities.
- When fitting out new electorate offices and refurbishing existing ones, Electorate
 Services is obligated to comply with requirements associated the Disability Discrimination
 Act.
- The Waite Electorate Office lease was recently extended with lease expiry now 28
 January 2023 with a further four year option to renew from 1 February 2023. The lessor
 has committed to a reduced rent over a 2 year period to contribute to the costs of
 upgrading the air conditioning and the installation of the bathroom facilities.
- The Support Services to Parliamentarians Budget cannot absorb the cost of the
 additional scope items and costs associated with staging and delayed commencement.
 Proposed refurbishment works and will require additional funding supplementation and
 expenditure authority for \$72,000 excluding GST for a February 2019 commencement
 date or \$76,200 excluding GST for an August 2019 commencement date.
- It is recommended that you approve additional funding supplementation and expenditure authority for the 2018-19 Support Services to Parliamentarians budget of \$72,000 for the refurbishment of the Waite Electorate Office to commence in the week commencing 18 February 2019.
