SUMMARY

During October, total employment:

- rose 0.3% in South Australia in <u>trend</u> terms (nationally, total employment rose 0.2%); and
- rose 0.2% in South Australia in <u>seasonally</u> <u>adjusted</u> terms (nationally, total employment rose 0.4%).

During October, the unemployment rate:

- was 3.6% in South Australia in **trend** terms (3.7% nationally); and
- was 3.6% in South Australia in seasonally adjusted terms (3.7% nationally).

FURTHER ANALYSIS

EMPLOYMENT

In **seasonally adjusted** terms in October:


- Total employment in South Australia rose by 2,300 (0.2%), following a fall of 0.2% in September—see Chart 1. Full-time employment fell by 1,000 while part-time employment rose by 3,300.
- Nationally, total employment rose by 55,000 (0.4%). Full-time employment rose by 17,000 and part-time employment rose by 37,900.

<u>Through the year</u> seasonally adjusted employment growth was 3.5% for South Australia and 3.0% nationally.


In trend terms in October:

- Total employment in South Australia rose by 2,600 (0.3%). Full-time employment fell by 100 and part-time employment rose by 2,700.
- Nationally, total employment rose by 28,300 (0.2%). Full-time employment rose by 2,000 and part-time employment rose by 26,300.

Through the year trend employment growth was 3.9% for South Australia and 2.8% nationally.



In the year to October, the number of employed 15 to 24 year olds in South Australia was 5.0% higher than a year earlier and 5.8% higher nationally (moving annual average terms)—see Chart 2.






UNEMPLOYMENT

In **trend** terms, the unemployment rate in South Australia fell from 3.7% in September to 3.6% in October. Nationally, the unemployment rate remained unchanged at 3.7% in October—see Table 1 and Chart 3.

In **seasonally adjusted** terms, South Australia's unemployment rate fell from 3.7% in September to 3.6% in October. Australia's unemployment rate rose from 3.6% in September to 3.7% in October.

In South Australia, the **youth** (15-24 year old) unemployment rate was 9.0% in the year to October, down from 9.3% a year earlier and above the 8.1% rate recorded nationally (**annual average terms**).


UNDEREMPLOYMENT

<u>Underemployed</u> workers are those who are employed part-time and who want, and are available for, more hours of work than they currently have.

The **trend** underemployment rate in South Australia was 7.5% in October. As a result the overall trend labour force <u>underutilisation</u> rate was 11.1% in October, up from 10.8% a year earlier. In October, the national underutilisation rate was 10.1%.

PARTICIPATION

In **trend** terms, the <u>participation rate</u> in South Australia remained unchanged at 64.3% in October. Nationally, the participation rate fell from 66.9% in September to 66.8% in October—see Chart 4.



In **seasonally adjusted** terms, the South Australian participation rate remained unchanged at 64.3% in October. Nationally, the participation rate rose 0.2 of a percentage point to 67.0%.



In **annual average terms**, the age groups that experienced the largest increases in participation in the year to September 2023 were 25-34 year olds (up 2.0pp) and 65-74 year olds (up 1.4pp). The age groups that experienced the lowest growth in participation over the same period were 45-54 year olds (unchanged) and 35-44 year olds (up 0.3pp)—see Table 2.



HOURS WORKED

In **trend** terms, monthly hours worked in all jobs rose by 0.1% in South Australia in October to be 4.2% higher than a year earlier—see Chart 5. Nationally, monthly hours worked in all jobs rose by 2.6% through the year to October.
