APPLICATION UNDER THE *FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1991*

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act), dated 29 May 2020.

Your application seeks access to:

"All minutes, briefings and correspondence titled 'Kangaroo Island Sporting and Community Infrastructure' as described on the Objective document management system, between 14 November 2019 and 29 May 2020."

The prescribed legislative timeframe to determine this application has expired and is now deemed as refused access to documents relevant to your application. I refer to my letter dated 12 June 2020 where I sought additional time to make my determination.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of my determination. An extensive search was conducted within this office. A total of 2 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application.


