Freedom of Information – Traffic offences in SA Government cars

I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), received by the Department of Treasury and Finance (DTF) on 8 October 2018.

Your application specifically requested:

'I'm seeking documents containing the following: Specifically, I am seeking access to documents, photos and video footage, produced since 1 January, 2017 to the date of this application relating to: a) Traffic infringements, including speeding, drink driving and parking fines involving drivers of SA Government cars Without limiting my application, I would expect it to include the date of the offence, details of the offence, the penalty incurred, when and where it occurred. And if they hold a position where they have been elected to public office, I would also expect their names to be included. Please exclude third party personal details such as names and addresses. Please exclude duplicates, documents that have already been publicly released, media reports/article/statements and any correspondence with media. I consent to edited copies of documents/video with exempt material redacted/pixilated. Please note, I do not consent to documents being deemed irrelevant without consultation.'

As clarified with you, the documents only relate to SA Government cars managed by DTF, not whole of government.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of my determination.

A total of 15 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application and I have determined as follows:

- I grant you access in full to 3 documents, copies of which are enclosed, and
- I grant you access in part to 12 documents, copies of which are enclosed.

Please refer to the attached schedule that describes each document and sets out my determination and reasons in summary form.

Documents released in full

Documents 11, 13, 15

Documents released in part

Documents 1 – 10, 12, 14

These documents consist of information relating to the personal affairs of government employees. Under clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 to the Act, a document is exempt if its disclosure would involve the 'unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person'. This information falls within the definition of personal affairs under the Act and is therefore exempt from release pursuant to clause 6(1).

Exemptions

Clause 6 – Documents affecting personal affairs

- (1) *A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)*

Please note, in compliance with Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045 - *Disclosure Logs for Non-Personal Information Released through Freedom of Information (PC045)*, DTF is now required to publish a log of all non-personal information released under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*.

Appeal Rights

If you are aggrieved with this determination, you have a right to apply for internal review under subsection 29(1) of the FOI Act. Pursuant to subsection 29(2), your application must:

- be in writing
- be accompanied by the application fee of \$35.00
- be addressed to the principal officer, and
- be lodged at an office of DTF, or emailed to freedomofinformation2@sa.gov.au within 30 days after the day on which you receive this letter or within such further time as the principal officer may allow.
