**APPLICATION UNDER THE *FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1991***

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), received in this office on 14 February 2019.

Your application seeks access to:

*"All correspondence (but not limited to letters, emails, notes) from the Member for King – Ms Paula Luethen MP and the Member for Newland – Dr Richard Harvey MP regarding the closure of the Service SA branch at Modbury and the responses (and associated Ministerial briefing/minute) provided to any correspondence within 1 July to 1 December 2018. Also any documents, briefing notes or Ministerial briefing/minute that have been provided to the Member for King – Ms Paula Luethen and the Member for Newland – Dr Richard Harvey regarding the closure of the Service SA branch at Modbury between 1 July 2018 to 1 December 2018."*

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of my determination. An extensive search was conducted within this office. A total of 2 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application and I have determined to release both documents in part, as these contain information of a personal nature which if released, would be an unreasonable disclosure of personal affairs. I have determined to exempt this information pursuant to clause 6(1).

Please note, in compliance with Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045 - *Disclosure Logs for Non-Personal Information Released through Freedom of Information* (PC045), The Department of Treasury and Finance is now required to publish a log of all non-personal information released under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*.

Alternatively, you can apply to the South Australian Civil and Administrative Tribunal. If you wish to seek a review, Section 39(3) of the Act states you must do so within 30 calendar days of receiving the determination.
