Freedom of Information – South Australia Productivity Commission

I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), received by the Department of Treasury and Finance (DTF) on 12 December 2018.

Your application specifically requested:

'All correspondence held by the Department of Treasury and Finance in relation to the South Australian Productivity Commission [Date Range: 26/07/2018 to 12/12/2018]'

In consultation with your office, this scope was amended to:

'All correspondence held by the Department of Treasury and Finance in relation to the South Australian Productivity Commission [Date Range: 26/07/2018 to 26/08/2018]'

Under the Act, an agency has 30 days to respond to a freedom of information request. As DTF did not respond to your request within the time frame required, the department is deemed to have refused you access to all documents relevant to your application. However, I have determined to process the request as if the statutory time frame had been met.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of my determination.

A total of 26 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application and I have determined as follows:

- I grant you access in full to 7 documents, copies of which are enclosed
- I grant you access in part to 5 documents, copies of which are enclosed, and
- I refuse you access to 14 documents.

Please refer to the attached schedule that describes each document and sets out my determination and reasons in summary form.

Documents released in full

Documents 1, 4, 6, 10 - 12, 15

Documents released in part

Documents 2, 7, 9

These documents contain information relating to the personal affairs of third parties. Under clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act 1991 (the Act), a document is exempt if its disclosure would involve the 'unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person'. In my view, it would be unreasonable to disclose this information and I have therefore determined to exempt it pursuant to clause 6(1).

Document 5, 8

These documents contain information which, if released, would disclose details concerning a deliberation or decision of Cabinet. I have therefore determined to exempt this information pursuant to clause 1(1)(e).

Documents refused in full

Documents 13 - 14, 17 - 20

These documents are drafts of documents that were specifically prepared for submission to Cabinet. I have therefore determined to refuse access to these documents pursuant to clause 1(1)(b).

Documents 16, 21 - 22

These documents consist of information which, if released, would disclose details concerning a deliberation or decision of Cabinet. I have therefore determined to exempt these documents pursuant to clause 1(1)(e).

Documents 4a, 8a

These documents are briefing papers specifically prepared for the use of the Minister in relation to a matter submitted to Cabinet. I have therefore exempted the documents pursuant to clause 1(1)(f) of the FOI Act.

Documents 3 - 3a

Under clause 10(1) of Schedule 1 to the FOI Act, information is exempt from disclosure if it would be privileged from production on the ground of legal professional privilege. These documents consist of legal advice provided to the government by its legal advisor, the Crown Solicitor, information which is subject to legal professional privilege. I have therefore determined to exempt these documents pursuant to clause 10(1).

Documents 7a

This document consists of information relating to the personal affairs of third parties, including curricula vitae. Under clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act, a document is exempt if its disclosure would involve the 'unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person'. In my view, it would be unreasonable to disclose this information and I have therefore determined to exempt the document pursuant to clause 6(1).

Exemptions

Clause 1 - Cabinet documents

- (1) A document is an exempt document -
 - (a) if it is a document that has been specifically prepared for submission to Cabinet (whether or not it has been so submitted); or
 - (b) if it is a preliminary draft of a document referred to in paragraph (1); or
 - (c) if it is a document that is a copy of or part of, or contains an extract from, a document referred to in paragraph (a) or (b); or
 - (e) if it contains matter the disclosure of which would disclose information concerning any deliberation or decision of Cabinet; or
 - (f) if it is a briefing paper specifically prepared for the use of a Minister in relation to a matter submitted, or proposed to be submitted to Cabinet.

Clause 6 – Documents affecting personal affairs

(1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).

Clause 9 - Internal working documents

- (1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter—
 - (a) that relates to—
 - (i) any opinion, advice or recommendation that has been obtained, prepared or recorded; or
 - (ii) any consultation or deliberation that has taken place, in the course of, or for the purpose of, the decision-making functions of the Government, a Minister or an agency; and
 - (b) the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

Clause 10 - Legal Professional Privilege

(1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter that would be privileged from production in legal proceedings on the ground of legal professional privilege.

Please note, in compliance with Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045 - *Disclosure Logs for Non-Personal Information Released through Freedom of Information* (PC045), DTF is now required to publish a log of all non-personal information released under the *Freedom of Information Act* 1991.

Appeal Rights

- be lodged at an office of DTF, or emailed to freedomofinformation2@sa.gov.au within 30 days after the day on which you receive this letter or within such further time as the principal officer may allow.

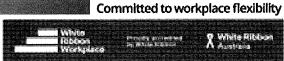
