SUMMARY

During December, total employment:

- rose 0.2% in South Australia in <u>trend</u> terms (nationally, total employment also rose 0.2%);
 and
- rose 0.3% in South Australia in <u>seasonally</u> <u>adjusted</u> terms (nationally, total employment fell 0.1%).

During December, the unemployment rate:

- was 4.0% in South Australia in **trend** terms (3.5% nationally); and
- was 3.9% in South Australia in seasonally adjusted terms (3.5% nationally).

FURTHER ANALYSIS EMPLOYMENT

In **trend** terms, total employment in South Australia rose by 1,900 (0.2%), and rose by 26,500 (0.2%) nationally in December—see Chart 1.


- In South Australia, full-time employment rose by 600 (0.1%) and part-time employment rose by 1,300 (0.4%).
- Nationally, full-time employment rose by 25,700 (0.3%) and part-time employment rose by by 800.

<u>Through the year</u> trend employment growth was 2.5% for South Australia and 3.5% nationally.


In **seasonally adjusted** terms, total employment in South Australia rose by 2,900 (0.3%) in December, following a fall of 0.1% in November. Employment fell by 14,600 (0.1%) nationally.

- In South Australia, full-time employment rose by 6,500 (1.1%) while part-time employment fell by 3,600 (1.1%).
- Nationally, full-time employment rose by 17,600 (0.2%) and part-time employment fell by 32,200 (0.8%).

Through the year seasonally adjusted employment growth was 2.2% for South Australia and 3.4% nationally.



In the year to December, the number of employed 15 to 24 year olds in South Australia was 7.8% higher than a year earlier and 9.9% higher nationally (moving annual average terms)—see Chart 2.








UNEMPLOYMENT

In **trend** terms, the unemployment rate in South Australia remained unchanged at 4.0% in December. Nationally, the unemployment rate also remained unchanged in December at 3.5%—see Table 1 and Chart 3.

In **seasonally adjusted** terms, South Australia's unemployment rate fell from 4.1% in November to 3.9% in December. Australia's unemployment rate remained unchanged in December at 3.5%.

In South Australia, the **youth** (15-24 year old) unemployment rate was 9.6% in the year to December, down from 12.2% a year earlier but above the 8.2% rate recorded nationally (**annual average terms**).


UNDEREMPLOYMENT

<u>Underemployed</u> workers are those who are employed part-time and who want, and are available for, more hours of work than they currently have.

The **trend** underemployment rate in South Australia was 7.1% in December. As a result the overall trend labour force <u>underutilisation</u> rate was 11.1% in December, down from 12.9% a year earlier. In December, the national underutilisation rate was 9.4%.

PARTICIPATION

In **trend** terms, the <u>participation rate</u> in South Australia remained unchanged at 63.5% in December. Nationally, the participation rate also remained unchanged in December at 66.7% —see Chart 4.



In **seasonally adjusted** terms, the South Australian participation rate rose from 63.4% in November to 63.5% in December. Nationally, the participation rate fell 0.2 of a percentage point to 66.6%.



In **annual average terms**, the age groups that experienced the largest increases in participation in the year to November 2022 were 15-24 year olds (up 2.6pp) and 55-64 year olds (up 1.9pp). The age groups that experienced the largest declines in participation over the same period were 65-74 year olds (down 1.4pp) and 45-54 year olds (down 0.8pp) —see Table 2.



HOURS WORKED

In **trend** terms, monthly hours worked in all jobs rose by 0.2% in South Australia in December and were 1.9% higher than a year earlier—see Chart 5. Nationally, monthly hours worked in all jobs rose by 4.0% through the year to December.
