SUMMARY

During November, total employment:

- rose 0.3% in South Australia in <u>trend</u> terms (nationally, total employment rose 0.2%); and
- fell 0.1% in South Australia in <u>seasonally</u> <u>adjusted</u> terms (nationally, total employment rose 0.5%).

During November, the unemployment rate:

- was 4.1% in South Australia in **trend** terms (3.5% nationally); and
- was 4.1% in South Australia in **seasonally adjusted** terms (3.4% nationally).

FURTHER ANALYSIS

EMPLOYMENT

In **trend** terms, total employment in South Australia rose by 2,400 (0.3%), and rose by 32,600 (0.2%) nationally in November—see Chart 1.


- In South Australia, full-time employment remained unchanged and part-time employment rose by 2,300 (0.7%).
- Nationally, full-time employment rose by 26,400 (0.3%) and part-time employment rose by 6,300 (0.2%).

<u>Through the year</u> trend employment growth was 2.6% for South Australia and 3.8% nationally.


In **seasonally adjusted** terms, total employment in South Australia fell by 1,300 (0.1%) in November, following a rise of 1.4% in October. Employment rose by 64,000 (0.5%) nationally.

- In South Australia, full-time employment fell by 9,200 (1.5%) while part-time employment rose by 7,900 (2.6%).
- Nationally, full-time employment rose by 34,200 (0.4%) and part-time employment rose by 29,800 (0.7%).

Through the year seasonally adjusted employment growth was 1.6% for South Australia and 4.2% nationally.



In the year to November, the number of employed 15 to 24 year olds in South Australia was 8.4% higher than a year earlier and 9.9% higher nationally (moving annual average terms)—see Chart 2.






UNEMPLOYMENT

In **trend** terms, the unemployment rate in South Australia remained unchanged at 4.1% in November. Nationally, the unemployment rate also remained unchanged at 3.5% —see Table 1 and Chart 3.

In **seasonally adjusted** terms, South Australia's unemployment rate remained unchanged at 4.1% in November. Australia's unemployment rate also remained unchanged at 3.4.

In South Australia, the **youth** (15-24 year old) unemployment rate was 9.4% in the year to November, down from 12.8% a year earlier but above the 8.3% rate recorded nationally (**annual average terms**).


UNDEREMPLOYMENT

<u>Underemployed</u> workers are those who are employed part-time and who want, and are available for, more hours of work than they currently have.

The **trend** underemployment rate in South Australia was 6.7% in November. As a result the overall trend labour force <u>underutilisation</u> rate was 10.8% in November, down from 13.1% a year earlier. In November, the national underutilisation rate was 9.3%.

PARTICIPATION

In **trend** terms, the <u>participation rate</u> in South Australia rose from 63.4% in October to 63.5% in November. Nationally, the participation rate remained unchanged at 66.7% —see Chart 4.



In **seasonally adjusted** terms, the South Australian participation rate fell 0.2 of a percentage point to 63.4% in November. Nationally, the participation rate rose 0.2 of a percentage point to 66.8%.



In **annual average terms**, The age groups that experienced the largest increases in participation in the year to October 2022 were 15-24 year olds (up 2.4pp) and 55-64 year olds (up 2.0pp). The age groups that experienced declines in participation over the same period were 65-74 year olds (down 1.4pp) and 45-54 year olds (down 0.8pp) —see Table 2.



HOURS WORKED

In **trend** terms, monthly hours worked in all jobs rose by 0.2% in South Australia in November to be 1.5% higher than a year earlier—see Chart 5. Nationally, monthly hours worked in all jobs rose by 4.5% through the year to November.
